We are at the limit of the **point of no return** in the most relevant issue that summons us as humanity: climate change.

We have experienced 1.2 C of global warming since the pre-industrial period. **Even 1.5 C of warming is dangerous**. Under current trends, scientists estimate the probability of limiting the temperature to 2 C at 5%.





"The world has changed. This is one of the biggest risks for companies, not understanding those changes. There is a crisis of confidence in the future. It is the risk of thinking that the future is bad. However, the positive aspects must be seen, and the status quo must be set aside, even though it has benefited us"
